IN an effort to halt speculation and stabilise the foreign exchange market, the Bank of Ghana will hold a series of discussions with the

leadership of universal banks and forex bureau operators, starting from today.

The Minister of Information, Kojo Opong Nkrumah, who made this known at a press briefing in Accra yesterday, said it was envisaged that the crucial meeting would ultimately ensure that measures were put in

place to streamline, sanitise and provide clarity on the supply chain of the foreign exchange market.

That, he noted, would ensure that traders who needed foreign currencies for legitimate transactions would have access to them at official rates.

The Information Minister said the engagements would also help provide knowledge to traders and other entities as to where to look for foreign exchange in order to prevent them from dealing with black marketers who bought the
